Trees have a tremendous impact on local economies and our quality-of-life.

Here's a peek at how urban trees in your state are contributing.



9,602 people are employed as a result of urban forestry activities in Arizona.



Communities in Arizona enrolled in Tree City USA® invested an

average of \$3.72 per

resident for tree planting and
care compared to \$3.00 per

resident in non-participating communities nationally.



Urban trees in the state contribute **\$230 million** in community-wide environmental benefits each year, such as carbon sequestration, air pollution removal, and avoided stormwater runoff.

The urban forestry sector in Arizona has an annual sales and employment footprint

worth \$1.0 billion.



Tree cover at private homes adds
