706 people are employed as a result of urban forestry activities in North Dakota.



Communities in North Dakota enrolled in Tree City USA® invested an average of **\$13.01 per**

resident for tree planting and care compared to \$3.00 per

resident in non-participating communities nationally.



Urban trees in the state contribute **\$67.6 million** in community-wide environmental benefits each year, such as carbon sequestration, air pollution removal, and avoided stormwater runoff.
