

ECONOMICS OF URBAN FORESTRY IN OHIO

Trees have a tremendous impact on local economies and our quality-of-life.

Here's a peek at how urban trees in your state are contributing.



22,566 people are employed as a result of urban forestry activities in Ohio.



Communities in Ohio enrolled in Tree City USA® invested an average of **\$7.81 per resident** for tree planting and care compared to **\$3.00 per**

resident in non-participating communities nationally.



Urban trees in the state contribute **\$2.4 billion** in community-wide environmental benefits each year, such as carbon sequestration, air pollution removal, and avoided stormwater runoff.

The urban forestry sector in Ohio has an annual sales and employment footprint

worth \$2.9 billion.



Tree cover at private homes adds **\$1.1 billion** annually to property values across Ohio.
