

ECONOMICS OF URBAN FORESTRY IN SOUTH CAROLINA

Trees have a tremendous impact on local economies and our quality-of-life.

Here's a peek at how urban trees in your state are contributing.



4,148 people are employed as a result of urban forestry activities in South Carolina.



Communities in South Carolina enrolled in Tree City USA® invested an average of **\$8.44 per**

resident for tree planting and
care compared to \$3.00 per

resident in non-participating communities nationally.



Urban trees in the state contribute **\$3.8 billion** in community-wide environmental benefits each year, such as carbon sequestration, air pollution removal, and avoided stormwater runoff.

The urban forestry sector in South Carolina has an annual sales and employment footprint

worth \$446 million.



Tree cover at private homes adds **\$1.1 billion** annually to property

values across South Carolina.
