

## ECONOMICS OF URBAN FORESTRY IN WYOMING

Trees have a tremendous impact on local economies and our quality-of-life.

Here's a peek at how urban trees in your state are contributing.



**716** people are employed as a result of urban forestry activities in Wyoming.



Communities in Wyoming enrolled in Tree City USA® invested an average of **\$7.44 per** 

resident for tree planting and
care compared to \$3.00 per

**resident** in non-participating communities nationally.



Urban trees in the state contribute **\$450 million** in community-wide environmental benefits each year, such as carbon sequestration, air pollution removal, and avoided stormwater runoff.

The urban forestry sector in Wyoming has an annual sales and employment footprint

worth \$52.0 million.



Tree cover at private homes adds **\$10 million** annually to property values across Wyoming.
